



Instructions for Use

Important

- This product is intended to be used by a professional with appropriate training and experience
- Do not attempt to use the Sales Syringe Adapter (SSA) before completely reading and understanding the information contained in this Instructions for Use



Intended Use: The Sales Syringe Adapter is intended to aid the user's dexterity in an applicable setting by enhancing the user's grip, control, and comfort in operating a syringe during one handed microsurgery procedures.

Contents of Packaging

- Depressor
- Grip
- Instructions for use

How Supplied: Devices are individually packaged, clean, and sterile.

Contraindications

Precautions

- ☐ Prior to use, inspect devices to ensure proper function and condition.
- Do not use the Syringe Adapter if it does not satisfactorily perform its intended function or if it has physical damage.
- Avoid mechanical shock or overstressing the devices.
- ☐ Caution, needs to be stored at room temperature to prevent deformation of device.
- ☐ Caution, not designed to displace the full length of the syringe
- ☐ If cracked, sharp edges can harm user or patient.

Warnings A

- Do not re-sterilize, as it could deform the device.
- ☐ This device is to be used on a BD Luer-Lok 1ml/1. cc syringe only. Incorrect type of syringe could result in dropping the syringe while injecting.
- ☐ If the "grip" is used, attach it around the Luer Lock region before attaching a hypodermic syringe needle. If done in contrary, can result in risk of needle puncture.
- ☐ The Sales Syringe Adapter is not a replacement for proper training and technique.
- ☐ In surgical procedures, do not use nonsterile device



Directions for Use

- To use a BD syringe Luer-Lok syringe, ensure all components are intact, functional, and packaged properly.
- 2. Position the barrel flange between the depressor arms and adjust the plunger for enhanced grip.
- 3. The "grip" component of the Sales Syringe Adapter should be snapped onto the barrel below the depressor arms.
- 4. Snap the barrel into the depressor by holding the round housing and syringe round plunger flange between the thumb and index fingers.
